

# How your donations help the women and children supported by the Patricia Giles Centre.

- Good quality furniture and household items are directly given to women and children to assist them furnish their home.
- Good quality clothes and toys are given to women and children in need.
- Excess clothing that is not immediately needed ( i.e. winter clothes that are donated in summer) are stored and given to families at the start of autumn.
- Excess items not required may be sold and the money used by PGC to assist in running the Centre.( e.g. therapeutic groups for women and children).

PGC recycles the following items:
